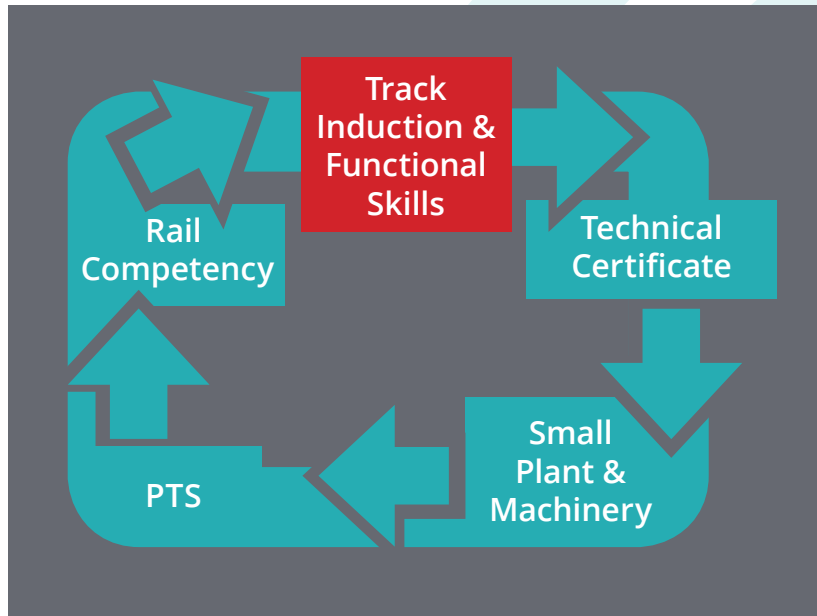


Apprenticeship Rail Engineering Levels 2 & 3
